



1. Leave the Market Place on the A689 towards Weardale and turn right at mini roundabout onto the B6298 signed for Billy Row;
2. Turn left onto White Lea Road at The Royal George near top of bank;
3. Follow along bearing right at T-junction passing East Park to emerge onto the A68;
4. Turn right onto A68 then after 1 mile take the left turn signed Thornley;
5. In Thornley Village turn left then right (minor roads) to follow road (scenic views of valley) to join B6297 (8 miles);
6. Turn left and left again to descend Redgate Bank into Wolsingham; steep, take care.
7. Leave Wolsingham following the A689 along Valley Road towards Crook (passing POW camp at Harperley);
8. At roundabout bear right to Fir Tree (14 miles);
