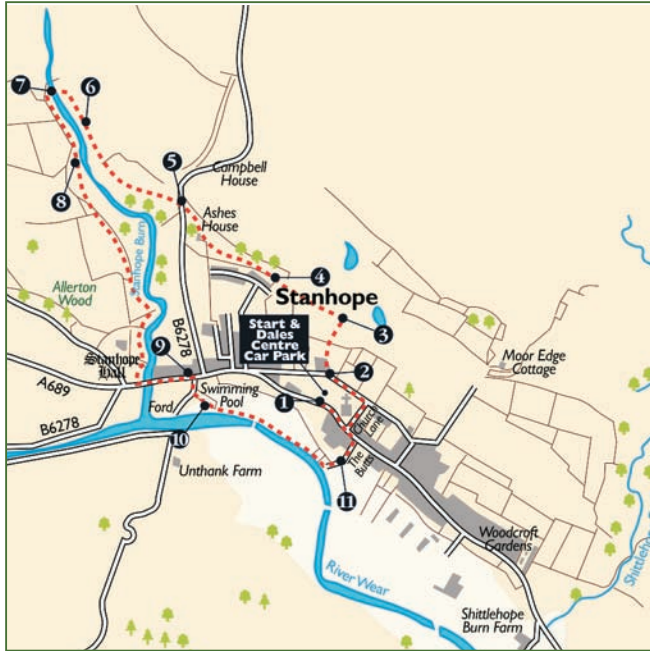

This Route is 2 ½ miles (4 km) long, over fairly easy terrain. Allow approximately 1 ½ hours to complete it. This route can also be added to the other combined Stanhope walks to make a 5 ½ mile (8 ¾ km) route.

1. From the Durham Dales Centre, turn left into the Market Place then left again up along a lane just before the Bonny Moor Hen, and then left again.
2. Turn right along the enclosed footpath after the Methodist Church.
3. Turn left at the track crossroads, passing between the old spoil heaps.
4. Cross the stile beside the gate, to continue along the track on to reach the road.
5. Cross the road, onto the tarmac lane and follow this bearing left then round to the right with the wooded ravine of Stanhope Burn to your left.
6. Head left off the lane along a footpath slanting down the wooded hillside.

7. Cross footbridge and head left along the clear path.
8. Keep fields on your right down to reach the main road beside Stanhope Old Hall.
9. Turn right at the Roddam Memorial Fountain.
10. Turn left after the swimming pool to join a riverside path.
11. Turn left again along The Butts back to the Market Place.

### Parking

There is free parking at the Durham Dales Centre, Stanhope.
