



This Route is a medium grade walk of 2 ½ miles (4 km), climbing up onto the ridge of Crawley Edge from where there are superb views of Weardale across the rooftops of Stanhope. This walk should take 1 ½ - 2 hours.

1. From the Durham Dales Centre turn left along the main road, through the Market Place and continue on along Front Street.
2. Turn left before the Queens Head up along Union Lane.
3. Where the lane bends up to the right, turn left along a steep path before Moor Edge Cottage.
4. The path becomes a grassy track above the houses – head straight on then follow the track round to the left passing above the enclosed plantation. Follow this clear, level track straight on along the top of Crawley Edge.
5. The track joins a road above the houses of Crawley Side through a gate. Turn left downhill.
6. Turn left before Campbell House along Field Row leading to Wear View.

7. Turn right, over two bridges passing through the old quarries back into Stanhope.
8. Turn right to Dales Centre.
